<b>Introduction (Organization)</b>	The introduction clearly states the main topic, at least 3 body paragraphs have a topic sentence and detail sentences; a conclusion paragraph summarizes and closes the essay.	The introduction states the main topic, 2-3 body paragraphs have a topic sentence and detail sentences; a conclusion paragraph summarizes and closes the essay.	The introduction states the main topic, 1-2 body paragraphs have a topic sentence with some detail sentences; a conclusion may be present. <b>Capitalization &amp; Punctuation (Conventions)</b>	Writer makes no errors in capitalization or punctuation, grammar and spelling, so the paper is exceptionally easy to read. Writer makes a few errors in capitalization, grammar, spelling, and/or punctuation that catch the reader's attention and interrupt the flow.
